What not to put in the bin?

Hazardous waste

Contaminated waste is to be collected separately: Batteries, rechargeable batteries, chemicals, poisons, electrical appliances (e.g. television set, toaster, PC, coffee percolator, vacuum cleaner, refrigerator, washing machine, electric cooker), energy-saving lamps, fluorescent tubes, varnish, solvent-based paints, spray cans with contents, solar power systems, night storage stove disposals, waste oils.

Building rubble

Concrete, bricks, tiles, stones and ceramics can be handed in for a fee, with a maximum of 200 liters per day at the following locations:

- Wertstoffhof Süd
- Wertstoffhof Fort Hartmann

Excavation soil, gypsum boards (Rigips), Ytong, and mineral wool are accepted only if sorted by type.

→ Larger quantities of construction waste as well as asbestos-containing materials can be accepted by private disposal companies.

Organic waste bin

Kitchen waste

residual vegetables, salad and fruit, (spoiled) residual food, potato peel, egg shells, citrus and fruit peel, nutshells, tea bags, coffee grounds with filter paper, kitchen paper towels

Garden waste

plant residues, foliage, flowers, soil from plant pots, lawn, tree and bush cuttings



Collect kitchen waste in paper bags (e.g., bakery bags) or wrap it in newspaper or used kitchen paper before placing it in the bin.

Attention! Please DO NOT use compostable plastic bags! They prevent recycling.
